Ans. a) Maps are small and handy.

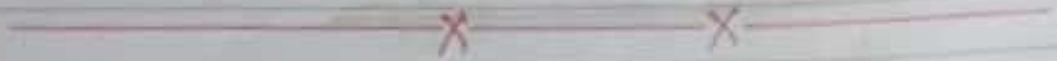
b) Maps can be folded and carried easily from place to place.
