Q.1. Define noun. Give examples.

Ans:- Noun: A noun is the name of a person, place, animal, thing, idea or emotion.
Eg: Premchand, India, Eagle, Toy, Honesty.

Ans: Common nouns: are the general names of people, places or things of the same kind.
Eg: school, train, writers, books.

∴ Common nouns: usually begin with small letters.

B. Proper nouns: are the names of particular people, places or things.

Eg: Arjit, July, Godan, The Taj Mahal.

∴ Proper nouns: usually begin with a capital letter.

C. Abstract nouns: are nouns that name ideas, qualities and feelings.

eg: kindness, Honesty, gentleness.

D. Collective nouns: are the names of groups of people, animals or things.

Eg: a flock of sheep.
